1. Image Specifications:

- Format: JPG/JPEG, max 25 MB, file renamed to participant's name.
- Post-processing is not allowed

2. Submission Procedure

3. Accompanying Information:

- Title or brief caption (related to observed behaviour, habitat, or any ecological relevance is encouraged)
- Species identification (if known)
- Affiliation of the contestant
- Date, location of capture and device used

4. Submission Deadline:

All entries must be submitted by **06:00 PM IST on 25th July 2025**. Late submissions will not be considered.

5. Awards and Recognition:

All participants will receive a digital certificate. The top three winners will get a free copy of the book "**Moths of India**", the next seven will receive a field guide "**Common Micromoths of India**". Selected photos may be featured on the NPC website [https://npc.iari.res.in/] and other outreach materials with proper credit.
