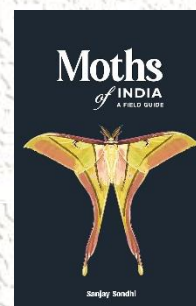

Enthusiasts of all ages set up light traps and bait stations to observe, photograph, and document moths, sharing records on platforms like iNaturalist, BugGuide, Moths of India, and Moth Photographers Group. These contributions aid scientific research on moth distribution, behaviour, and conservation. Often overlooked, moths play vital roles as pollinators, decomposers, and prey in ecosystems. The event unites individuals, institutions, and nature groups worldwide in celebrating Lepidoptera and promoting biodiversity awareness
